




	It incorporates automatic fuse trips (RCDs). A torch for emergencies is located in this cupboard.
Feedback	We would value your feedback on how we can improve the cottage to make others and hopefully your return stay even more enjoyable.

Fire alarms	Located in kitchen, lounge, all the bedrooms, first floor landing and second floor landing. A copy of the fire safety risk assessment for Lantern House is provided in the top left draw of the chest in the lounge.
Fire Extinguishers/ Blanket	There are 3 multi-purpose dry powder fire extinguishers located in the utility room, and 1st and 2nd floor landings.
	There is a foam spray fire extinguisher (safe for wood, paper, textiles and flammable liquids but not for live electrical equipment or metal fires) located in the front entrance porch. A fire blanket is located in the kitchen.
Heating	The central heating is left permanently on during Winter months and is controlled by thermostat in the lounge. It displays the actual temperature – turn the dial to display and set the desired temperature.
High Chairs	Two Stokke baby high chairs are kept in the utility room. An adjustment Allen key is kept on shelf beside it.

Hoover	In cupboard in lounge. A dustpan and brush is kept in the tall cupboard in the utility room to the left of the fridge freezer.
Hot water	Lantern House has an instantaneous hot water boiler, which should always be left on.
	Please note when running a bath to ease back the flow of the hot tap if you wish to increase temperature.
	If there is no hot water please check the hot water red light is showing on the programme switch in the utility room above the boiler. If not please press the button marked "water".
Hot water bottles	Located in cupboard next to sink.
Iron/ironing board	Located in tall cupboard in utility room to the left of the fridge freezer.
	Alternatively there is a local 24hr collect and return iron service – please contact Speedy Iron tel. 01666 503 900
Keys	A key ring with 2 keys is provided for the front door, and a key ring with 2 keys is provided for the kitchen door and courtyard exit door.
Library	The nearest public Libraries are in Tetbury and Malmesbury both 5 miles away.
Market days	Tetbury: every Wednesday.
Nappy changing	A purpose baby nappy changing unit is in the Nursery room.
	Please use the nappy bin provided in the Nursery room.
	Regretfully there is no local nappy recycling/ laundry service.

Newspaper	The local paper called "Wilts & Glos Standard" is issued every Thursday and includes a list of what's on/ local events. It can be purchased from the Post Office.
Pets	No pets are permitted in Lantern House for the benefit of all guests.
Places to visit	Leaflets on the varied and interesting places to visit are provided for reference in this Lantern House folder and inside the bureau in the lounge.

Post Office	Sherston village Post Office is a short walk down the High Street.

Public payphone	Located on the left a short walk down the High Street. Local telephone directories are provided in the top left draw of the chest in the lounge.



Pubs/ Eating Places	The Rattlebone Inn in Sherston has a good reputation for food. The Gumstool Inn, just outside of Tetbury at Calcot also does good food. The Kings Arms in Didmarton about 4 miles away is also good as well as the pub in Luckington approximately 3 miles away.
Rubbish/ recycling	When the kitchen bin is full please seal bag and place in the Black general refuse wheelie bin in the courtyard. Spare kitchen bin bags are under the sink.
	Cans and bottles may be put in the black recycling box in the courtyard, and plastic, paper and cardboard may be put in the Blue lidded recycling wheelie bin in the courtyard.
	Refuse & Recycling collection days are shown on the kitchen calendar - please put the relevant bin/ box outside the rear courtyard door the night before and bring in after collection.
Safety Information	Please read an important safety information sheet in this A-Z folder.
Smoking	Smoking is not permitted at Lantern House for the benefit and safety of all guests.
Spare light bulbs	Located in the cupboard above the microwave in the utility room.
Taxis	Local taxis service telephone cards for reference are inside the lounge bureau.
Torches	Torches for emergency use are located in the electricity fuse box cupboard on the wall to the right of the washing machine in the utility room, on hooks beside each fire extinguisher.
Tourist information	Nearest offices are in the towns of Tetbury (Tel: 01666 503 552) and Malmesbury (Tel: 01666 823748) both just over 5 miles away.
