

Families Welcome Information

Introduction

The following provides an overview of helpful information to help families with children, infants and babies get the most out of their holiday whilst staying in Lantern House.

Facilities

- Lantern house is a non-smoking and pet free cottage for the comfort of all our guests.
- Pushchairs/prams can be stored in the utility room off the kitchen or in the secure courtyard under the covered locked exit together with bicycles.
- There is a fully equipped Nursery room for little ones including: feeding chair, black out blind and curtains, baby listening device, toys and books, changing unit and mat, wooden cot, baby bath, potty, infant toilet seat and step, toys and books. Ample cot bedding, including a baby sleep bag and pillow are provided.
- A travel cot and blow up Bob the Builder toddler bed/ sleep bag are stored in the Nursery both the master bedroom and single bedroom can accommodate these.
- 2 fold-up bed rails are provided for younger children, which are stored in the single bedroom under the bed.
- 2 Stokke High Chairs are kept in the utility room together with harness and an adjustment Allen key.
- In the kitchen there is: bottle steam steriliser, and bottle/ food warmer. Children's cutlery, plates, dishes and drinking cups are provided too.
- A Nappy bin is kept in the Nursery. Regretfully there is no local nappy recycling/ laundry service.
- There is a fridge freezer in the utility room to store children's food.
- In the lounge there are children's: books, toys (in cupboard to right of fireplace under stairs), DVD/videos, games, and channels on freeview TV.



Safety & security

Baby listening/ monitoring

A wireless baby listening/ monitoring device is provided. The listening device is in the Nursery bedroom and the monitoring device is in the Master Bedroom, but they may be moved as needed.

Stair gates, child proof lock and socket cover

There is a lounge door at the bottom of the stair and stair gates on both the first and second floor landings.

There are also child safety covers on open electrical power sockets and a lock on the kitchen cupboard underneath the sink.

Carbon Monoxide sensors

Carbon Monoxide sensors are fitted in the utility room and lounge.

Wood burner

When using the wood burner please ensure the door is kept closed and the fire guard is in place to protect children/ babies. A child safety fire guard for use when children are in the cottage is stored in the cupboard under the stairs to the right of the wood burner.

Fire safety

Fire alarms are located in kitchen, lounge, all the bedrooms, first floor landing and second floor landing.

There are 3 multi-purpose dry powder fire extinguishers located in the utility room, and 1st and 2nd floor landings.

There is a foam spray fire extinguisher (safe for wood, paper, textiles and flammable liquids but not for live electrical equipment or metal fires) located in the front entrance porch. A fire blanket is located in the kitchen.

A copy of the fire safety risk assessment for Lantern House is provided in the top left draw of the chest in the lounge.

The front and rear doors are lockable from the both the inside and outside.

Accident and Emergency

Nearest A&E department (20.5miles) is at Frenchay Hospital, Frenchay Park Road, Frenchay, Bristol, BS16 1LE tel. 0117 970 1212

Cirencester Hospital (17miles) has a Minor Injuries Unit (MIU) and is at Tetbury Road, Cirencester, GL7 1UY tel. 01285-655711

In the event of an emergency you should call the emergency services number 999 using the red public payphone on the left of the High Street as you exit the cottage. If you have a mobile then dial 112 for emergency services.

There is an emergency defibrillator in the village located in a yellow box to the left of the Post Office.

When booking please note

- There are no age restrictions on children staying.
- Rental prices are inclusive, unless extra items are needed e.g. birthday cake, flowers, or champagne. We would be happy to arrange this on your behalf.
- A £100 damage deposit is taken when the balance of the booking is due (8 weeks before rental), which is refunded after your stay subject to no damage. Any minor breakages e.g. mug/cup are not charged for.

Provisions/ groceries

Provisions/ groceries can be bought from the nearby Post Office which stock local bread, eggs, provisions etc and baby/ children's goods such as nappies and food.

Nearest supermarkets are Tetbury (Tesco) and Malmesbury (Waitrose & Somerfields).

Places to eat with children

- Carpenters Arms, Sherston: play area for children, good food.
- Westonbirt Arboretum (~4 miles): play area and wooded area with indoor/ outdoor restaurant or outdoor cafe (entrance fee payable).
- Priory Inn Hotel/ Pub/ Restaurant, Tetbury (~7 miles): coffee/ cake bar with small play area. Restaurant has option for children to make their own pizza.
- Gumstool Inn, Calcot (~10 miles): excellent food, but no play area but good children's food.
- Hunters Hall, Kingscote (~12 miles): pub with big garden and play area with slide and swings. Take road to Tetbury. When you get to the Hare and Hounds Hotel take the road to the left through Westonbirt to A46. Follow road to Wootonunder-Edge and Hunters Hall is approx 2 miles on left.
- Ragged Cot, Minchinhampton (~14 miles): pub with garden and excellent food. Take road to Tetbury, then Avening and turn right at pub on corner to Minchinhampton Common. Pub is on "T" junction.
- Whitehall Garden Centre, Lacock (~15 miles): restaurant and good play area for children.



Places to visit and things to do with Children

The folder and bureau in the lounge contains lots of information flyers on places to visit and things to do with Children. It's also worth looking at things to do on www.cotswolds.com. Here is a sample:

- Local walks: there is an excellent choice of nearby local countryside walks suitable for all ages. Please refer to books, maps and leaflets in cottage.
- Cotswolds wildlife park, Burford: with over 250 species of animals, from ants to white rhinos and beautiful landscaped parkland and gardens.
- Cattle Country Adventure Park, Stroud: indoor and outdoor play areas suitable for all ages. Farm trail. Restaurant and gift shop.
- Model village, Bourton-on-Water: a model of the actual village, built in Cotswold stone to 1/9th scale.
- Cotswold Farm Park, Nr Bourton-on-Water: over 50 flocks and herds of British rare breeds of farm animals, seasonal farming demonstrations, children's activities, cafe and gift shop.
- Narrow Boat Day Trips, Bradford-upon- Avon
- Cotswold Leisure Centre, Cirencester: modern sports facilities and swimming pool (including separate infant/ baby pool)
- Magic Land, Cirencester: large indoor soft play area
- The Cotswold Water Park, South Cerney: 140 Lakes and wetlands covering 40 square miles, south of Cirencester great for outdoor pursuits.
